**Dear Mr. President,**

**We have the honor, in the Party of Progress and Socialism (Morocco), to address this letter to you, taking into consideration the voice of your country and the strong power it represents at the international level, and the institutional, ethical and political responsibilities that such a power should imply.**

**Nevertheless, you insist, Mr. President, on providing your support to Israel in its continuous attacks against Palestine, using all possible means. Among the latter, the veto which you have recently used against the Security Council draft resolution, demanding an immediate humanitarian ceasefire in Gaza, protection of Palestinian civilians, immediate and unconditional release of all hostages and delivery of humanitarian aids, in conformity with international laws and international humanitarian law.**

**This unconditional and unlimited support which we consider, in the Party of Progress and Socialism, as it is the case for most of the International public opinion, a decisional support to Israel in its extermination war against the people of Palestine, in all the Palestinian territories, and particularly in Gaza. This support does not only stand against the free will of peoples and peace lover forces all over the countries and continents but also against the values and principles on which your country has been built.**

**Mr. President,**

**The conflict in the Middle-East has not started on October 7, 2023, as some would like to promote and widespread, and the attack on Gaza is not a war against terrorism, as claimed by Israel, it is rather an attack against the Palestinian people and an occupation of their territories for 75 years. This is the strong reality which nobody can hide no matter the power of its media means, likewise, nobody can succeed in engaging a genocide against the Palestinian people whatever the ferocity and strength of the attacks.**

**Thus, Israel's claims to be using the right of self-defense is a false one which the incredible reality witnessed by the entire world can deny, as most of the victims are civilians, which make us in reality, facing a genocide, ethnic cleansing and crimes against humanity and against a people with no other means than its resilience and the facing of the situation with the very modest means in its possession.**

**Today, Israel, with your unacceptable support, continues its military destructive attack on Gaza, since October 7<sup>th</sup>, unscrupulously and without any consideration for any voice requesting the ceasefire, which results, according to UN sources, in about 18 000 martyrs and 47000 injured ones, most of them are women and children, in an unprecedented humanitarian disaster, a population threatened with starvation, a destruction of basic services infrastructures, including hospitals, schools, and worship places.**

**Worst of all, is that Israel, with its extreme aggressive practices, threatens, for sure, at the short and long term level, the regional and international peace. It is also building important historical and psychological barriers for the present and future generations, which will stand against any possibility of peaceful coexistence.**

**Mr. President,**

**The situation in Palestine threatens stability and security in the region, thus questioning the human consciousness and the international regime. Such a situation for which the government of Israel is totally responsible due to its extreme stubbornness, its continuous provocations, and its settlement policy as well as its total denial of the Palestinian peoples' rights and even of their existence.**

**Based on the above mentioned, we kindly ask you, Mr. President, to abandon your present approach in supporting the brutal Israeli aggression against Palestine and, in return, to use the position and power of your country in the international scene to take the necessary urgent measures to totally and immediately call for ceasefire, ease the situation and, along with other countries with great influence, and within the UN Council, launch serious and complete negotiations to which will take part the two main concerned parts, that is the Palestinian national authority represented by the Palestine Liberation Organization and Israel, to adopt a final solution for the two countries, based on the whole legitimate rights of the Palestinian people.**

**The only efficient way to establish fair, continuous and global peace, to make it possible for all people in the region to live in security, and to benefit from development and prosperity, is to make it possible for the Palestinian people to have their national rights, at the top of which, the right to enjoy living in good conditions, in an independent country, with Jerusalem as its capital city.**
